### 1. General description

The 74AHC273-Q100; 74AHCT273-Q100 is an octal positive-edge triggered D-type flip-flop. The device features clock (CP) and master reset ( $\overline{\text{MR}}$ ) inputs. The outputs Qn will assume the state of their corresponding D inputs that meet the set-up and hold time requirements on the LOW-to-HIGH clock (CP) transition. A LOW on  $\overline{\text{MR}}$  forces the outputs LOW independently of clock and data inputs. Inputs are overvoltage tolerant. This feature allows the use of these devices as translators in mixed voltage environments.

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.







#### Fig. 8. Test circuit for measuring switching times





Fig. 10. Package outline SOT360-1 (TSSOP20)




Fig. 11. Package outline SOT764-1 (DHVQFN20)
