1. General description

The 74AUP3G0434 is a dual inverter and single buffer.

Schmitt trigger action at all inputs makes the circuit tolerant of slower input rise and fall times across the entire V_{CC} range from 0.8 V to 3.6 V.

This device ensures a very low static and dynamic power consumption across the entire V_{CC} range from 0.8 V to 3.6 V.

This device is fully specified for partial Power-down applications using I_{OFF} . The I_{OFF} circuitry disables the output, preventing a damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

- I_{OFF} circuitry provides partial Power-down mode operation

- Multiple package options

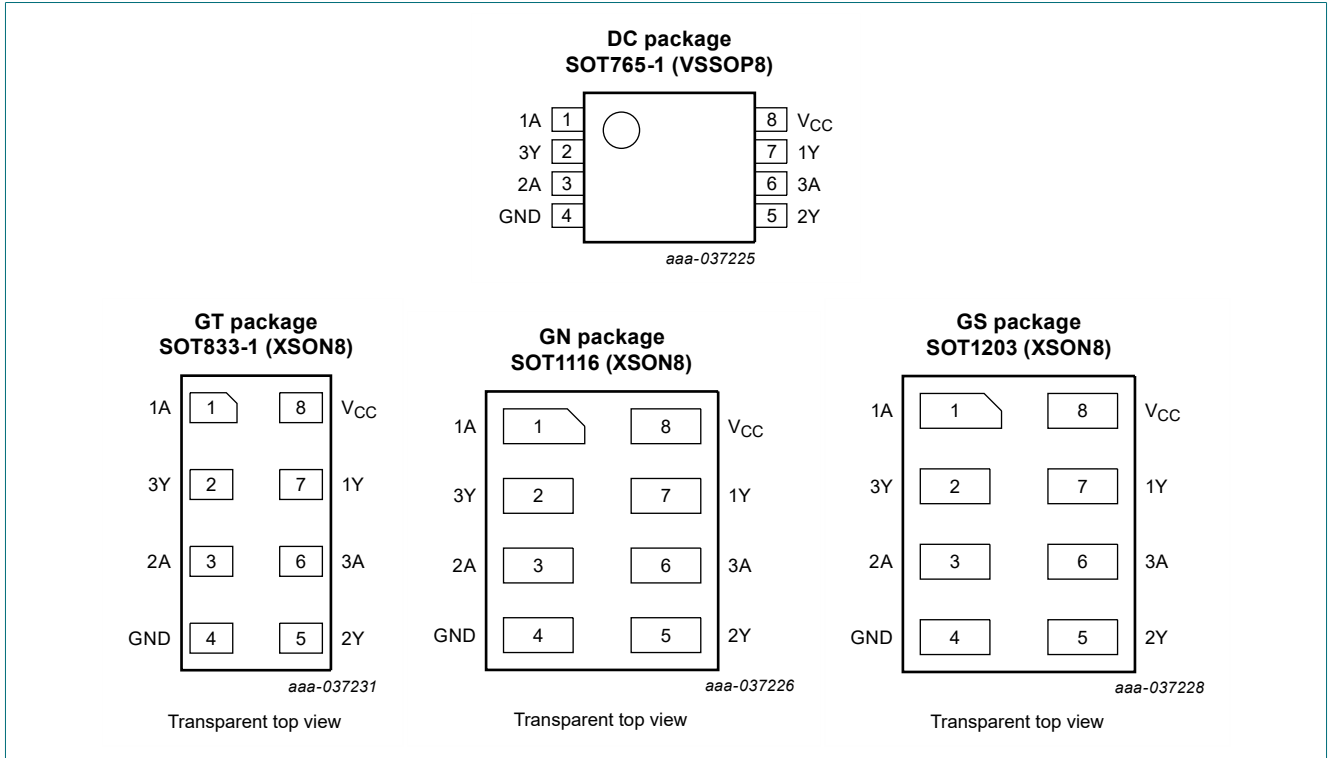

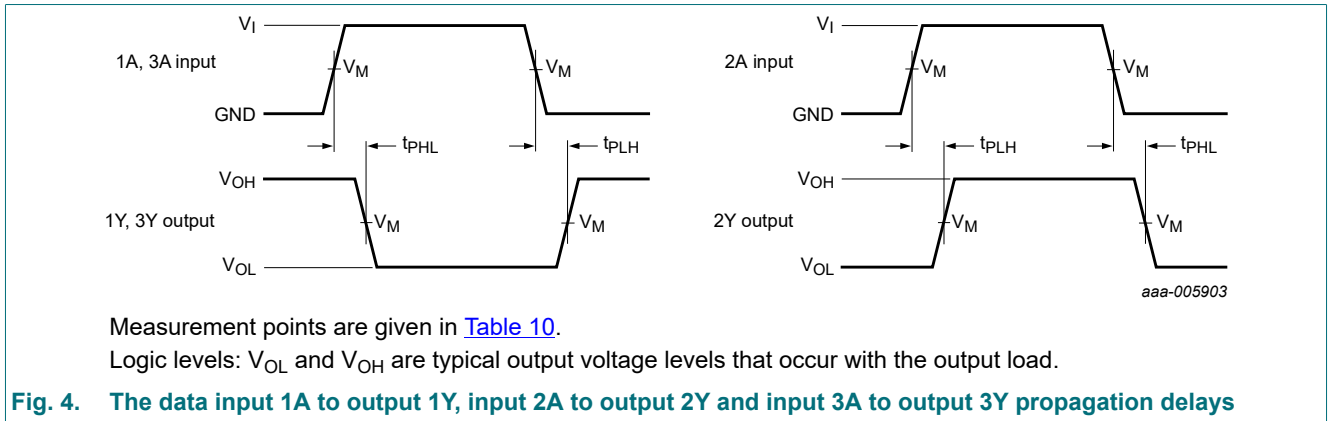


Fig. 4. The data input 1A to output 1Y, input 2A to output 2Y and input 3A to output 3Y propagation delays

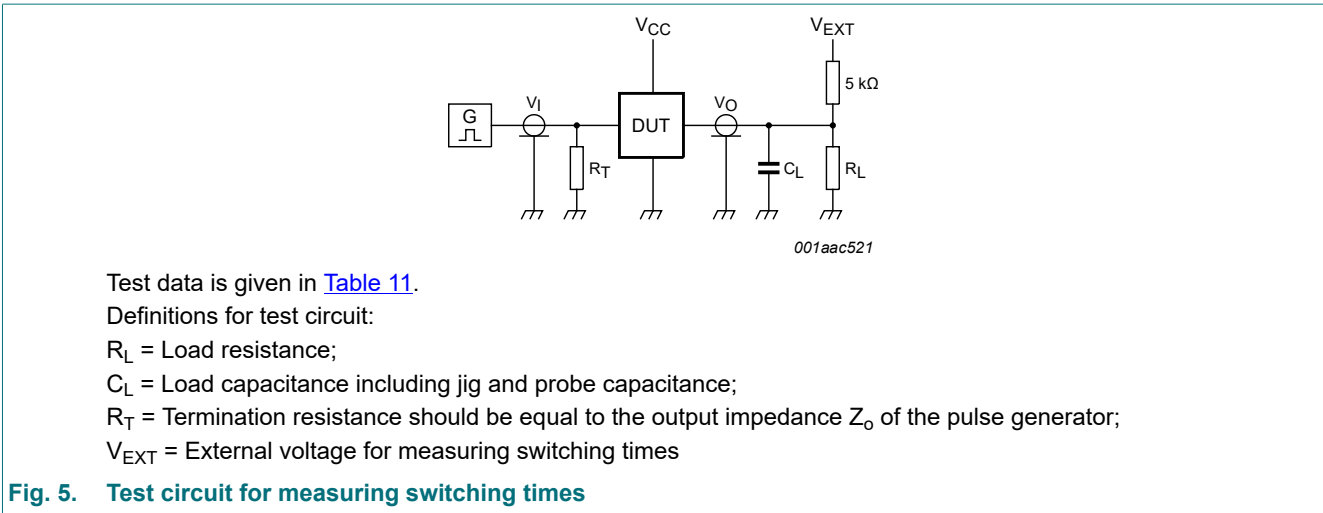


Fig. 5. Test circuit for measuring switching times

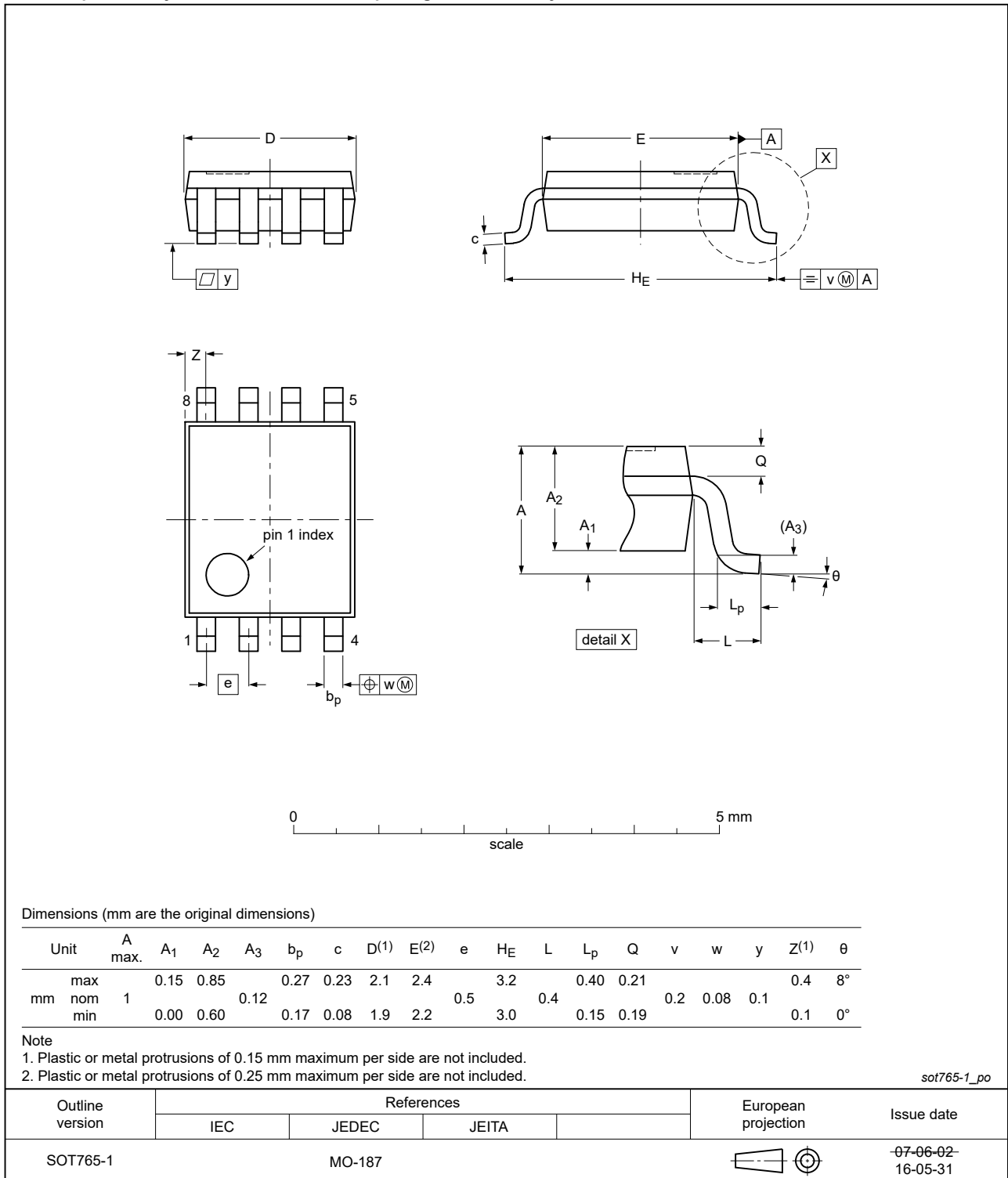


Fig. 6. Package outline SOT765-1 (VSSOP8)

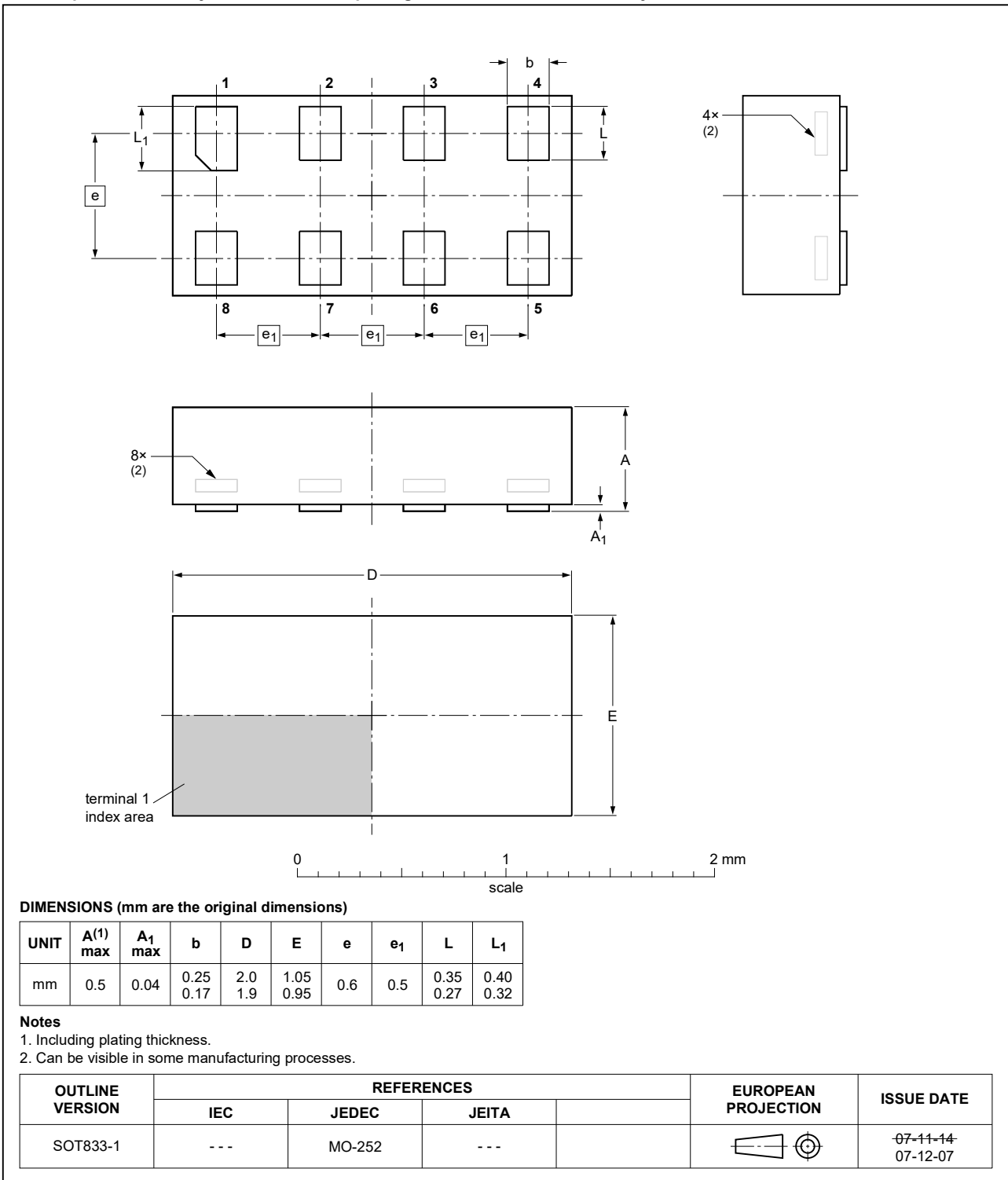


Fig. 7. Package outline SOT833-1 (XSON8)

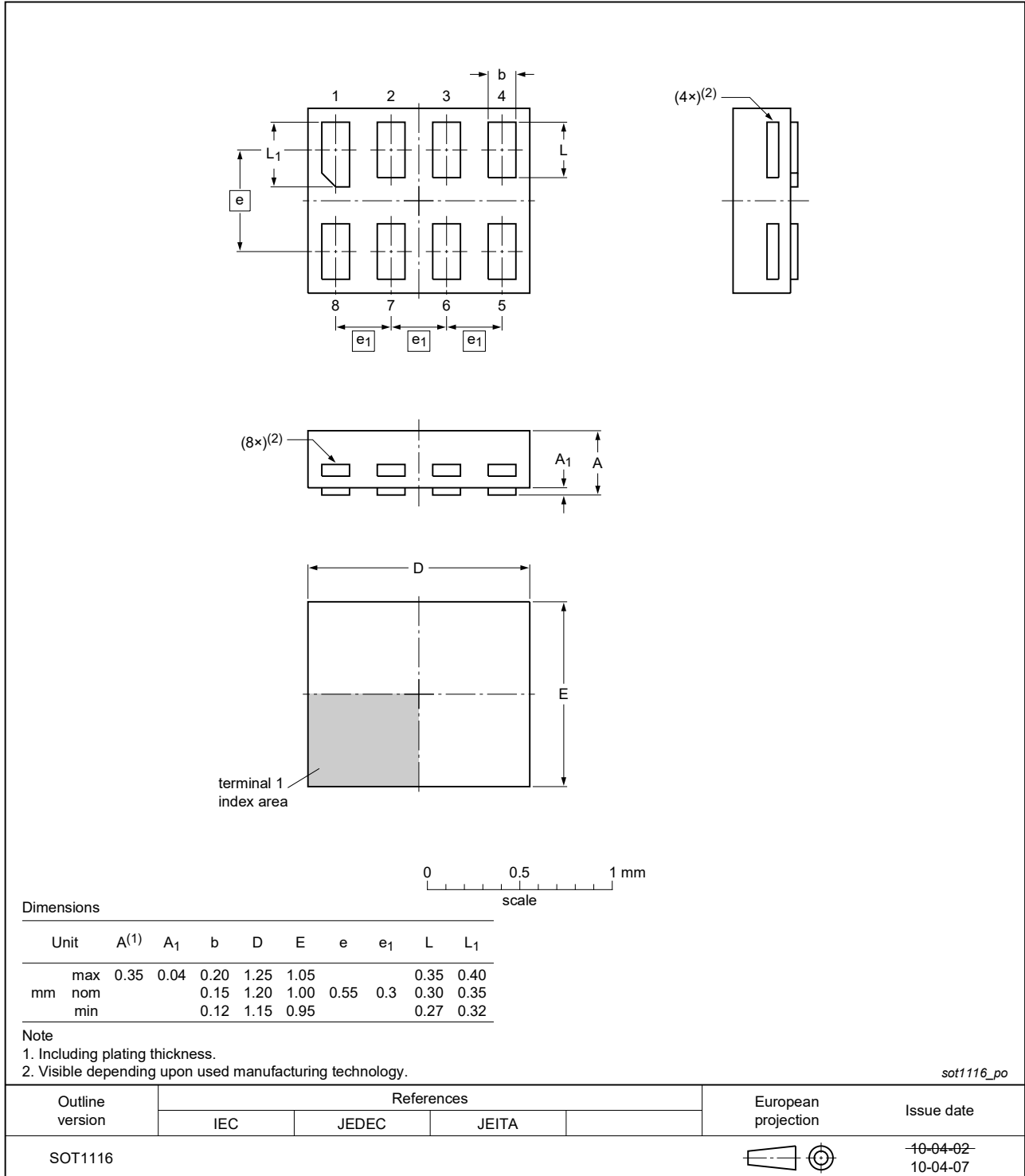


Fig. 8. Package outline SOT1116 (XSON8)

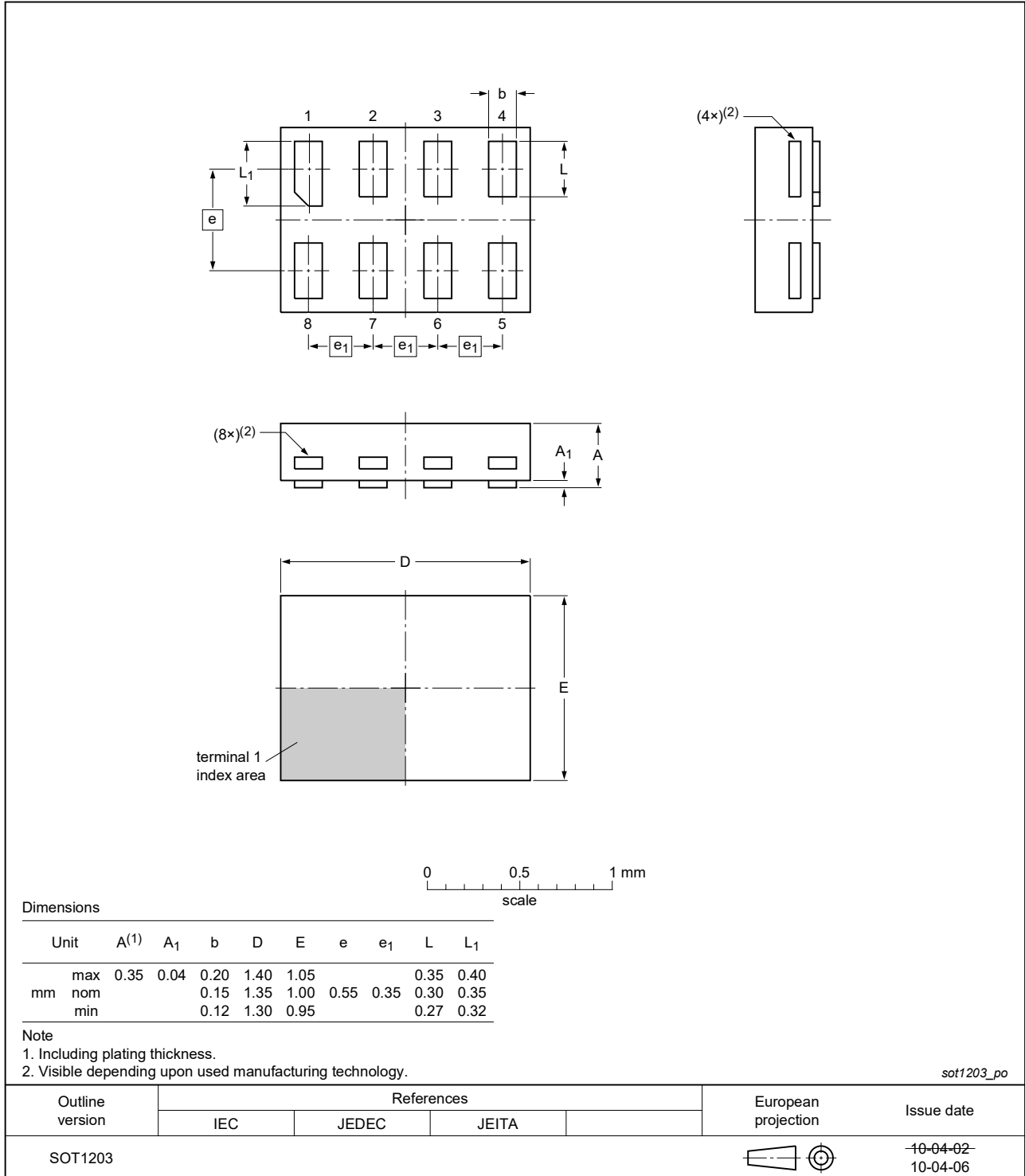


Fig. 9. Package outline SOT1203 (XSON8)
