1. General description

Single low leakage current switching diode, encapsulated in a leadless ultra small DFN1006-2 (SOD882) Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package.

2. Features and benefits

- Switching time typical: $t_{rr} = 0.8 \mu s$
- Low leakage current typical: $I_R = 3 \text{ pA}$
- Repetitive peak reverse voltage: $V_{RRM} \leq 85 \text{ V}$
- Low capacitance typical: $C_d = 2 \text{ pF}$
- Leadless ultra small SMD plastic package
- Low package height of 0.48 mm
- Qualified according to AEC-Q101 and recommended for use in automotive applications

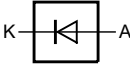

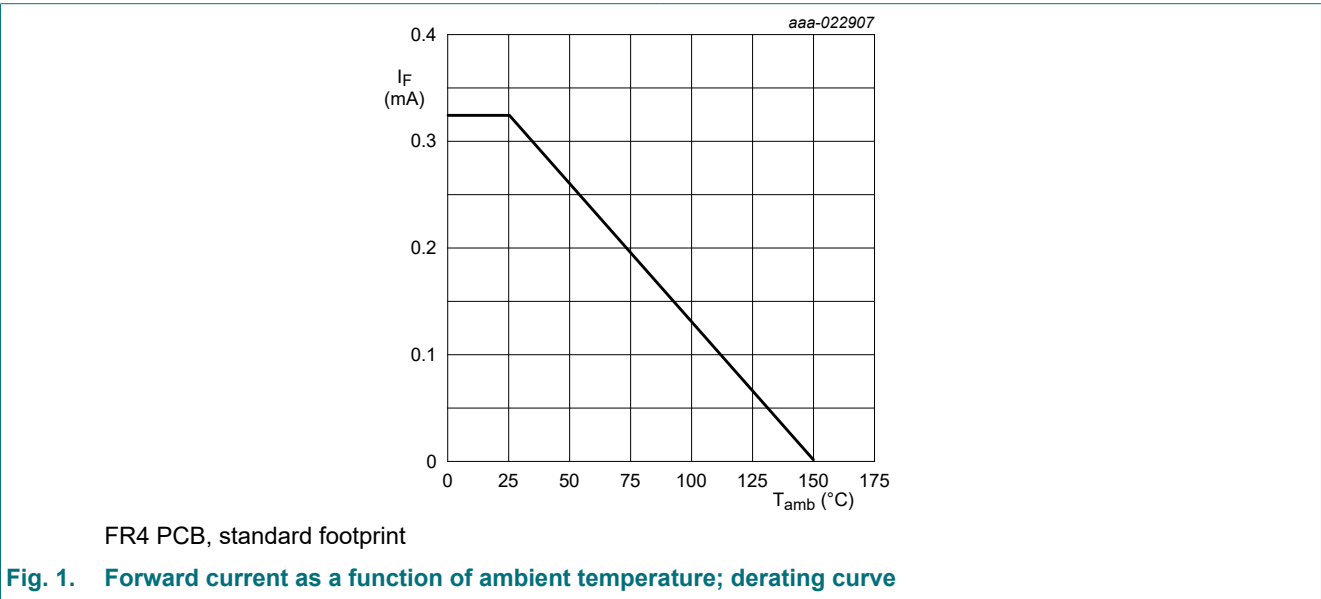

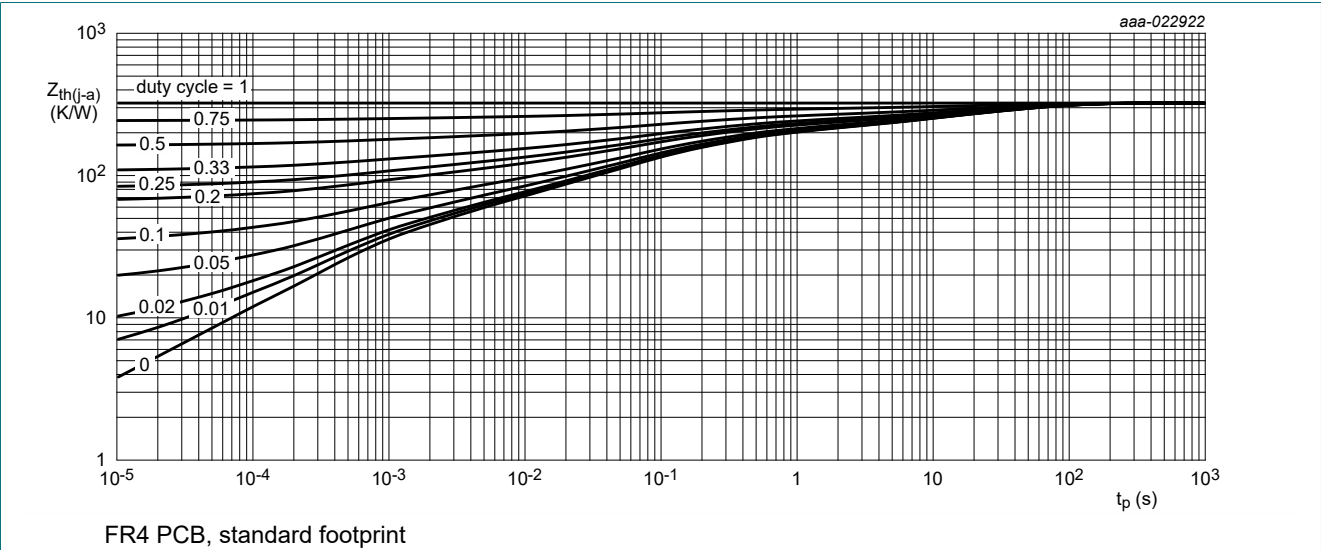


Fig. 2. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

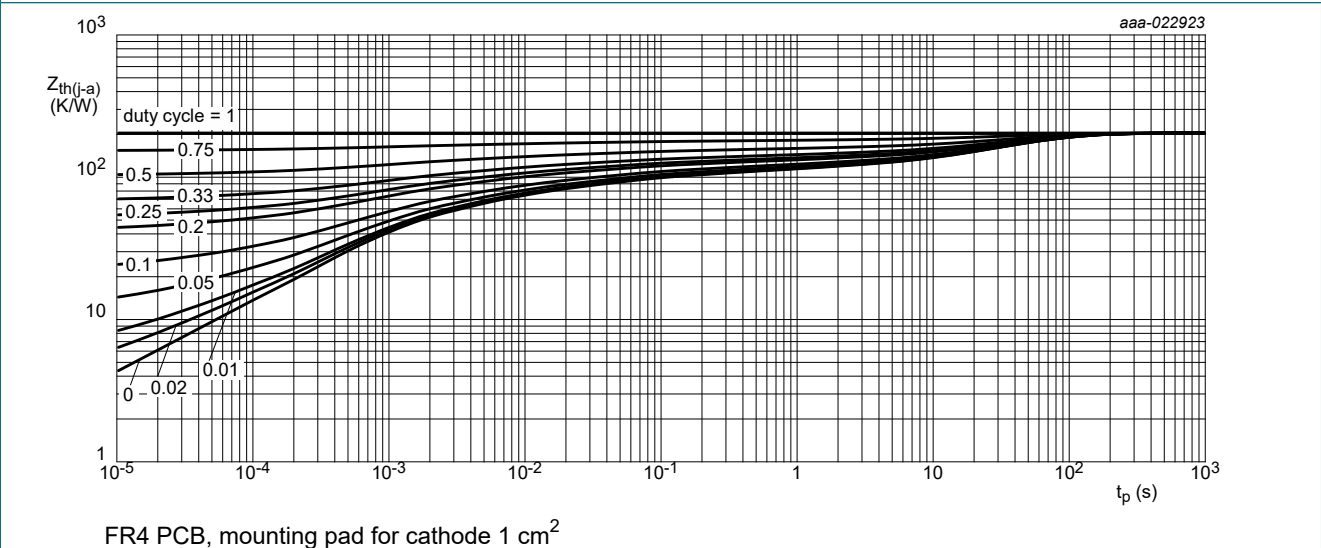
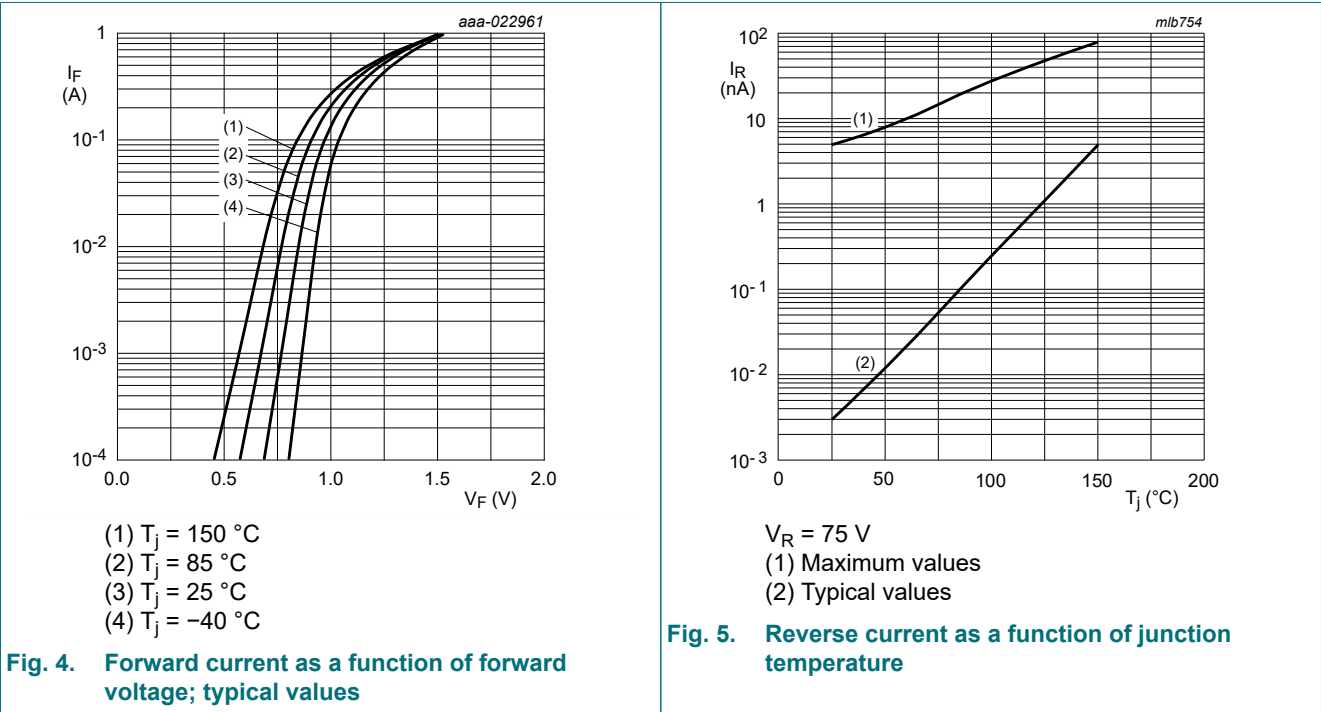


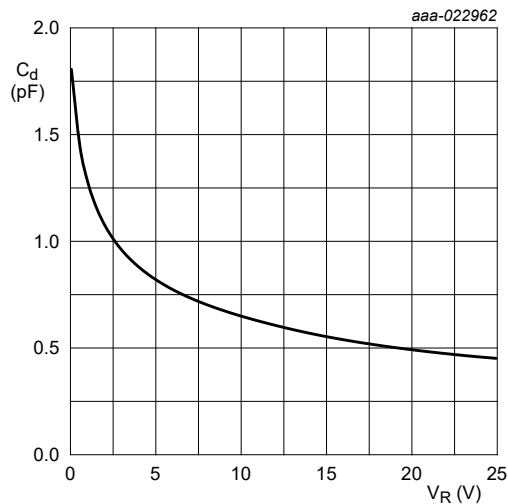
Fig. 3. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

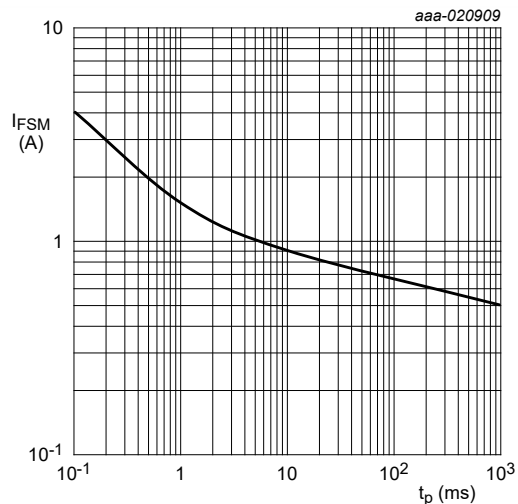

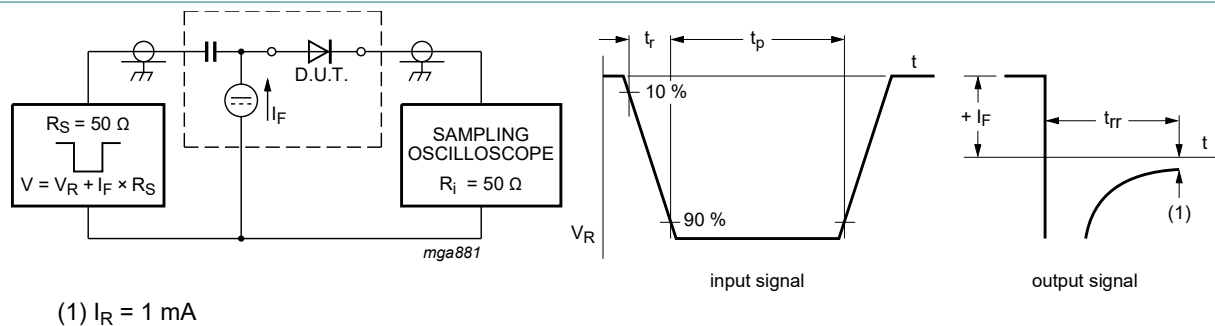
Fig. 6. Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values

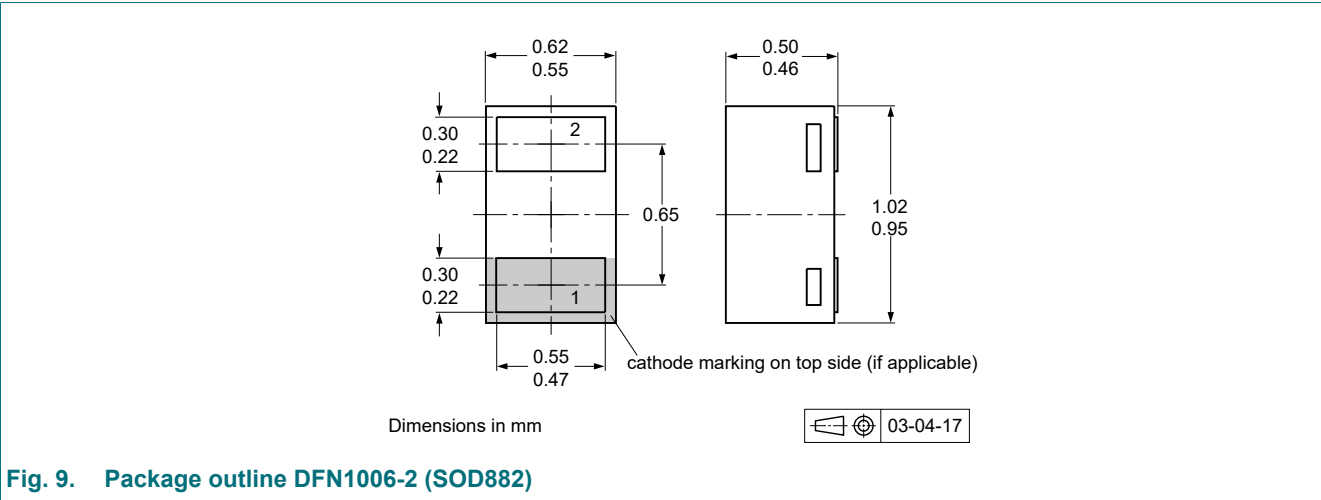

Fig. 8. Reverse recovery time test circuit and waveforms

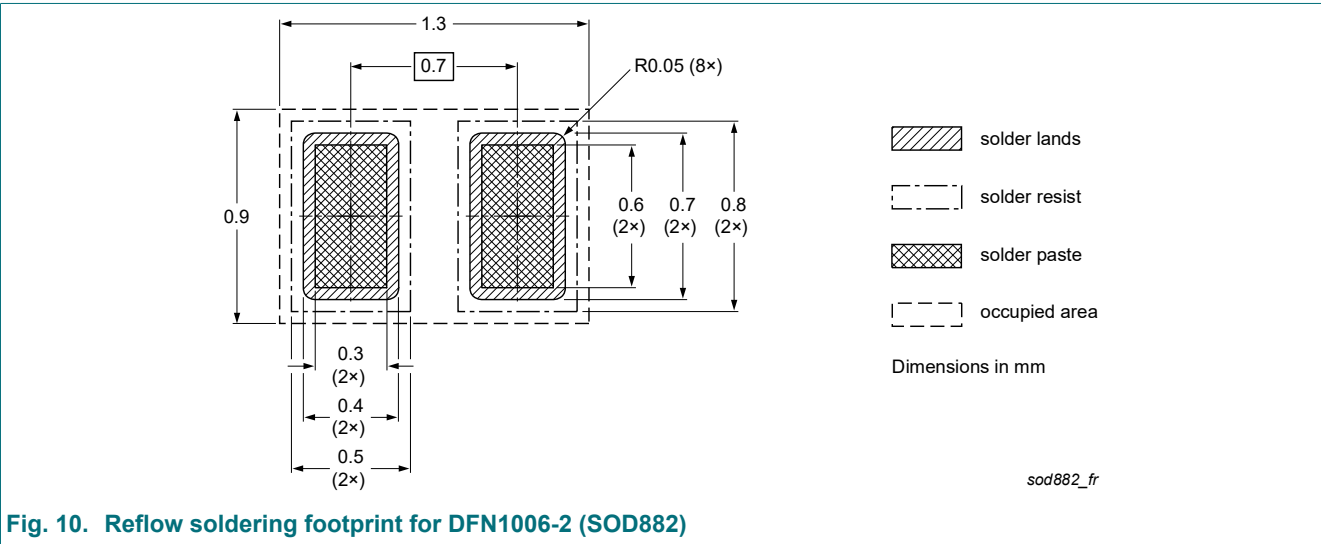
