## 1. General description

The HEF4073B-Q100 is a triple 3-input AND gate. Inputs include clamp diodes. This enables the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess of  $V_{CC}$ .

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 3) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.

## 2. Features and benefits

- Automotive product qualification in accordance with AEC-Q100 (Grade 3)
  - Specified from -40 °C to +85 °C
- Wide supply voltage range from 3.0 V to 15.0 V
- CMOS low power dissipation
- High noise immunity
- Complies with JEDEC standard JESD 13-B
- ESD protection:
  - HBM: ANSI/ESDA/JEDEC JS-001 class 2 exceeds 2000 V
  - CDM: ANSI/ESDA/JEDEC JS-002 class C3 exceeds 1000 V

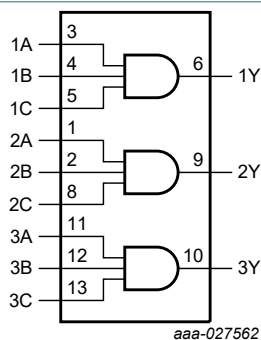


Fig. 1. Functional diagram

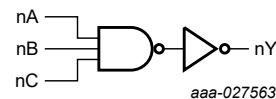
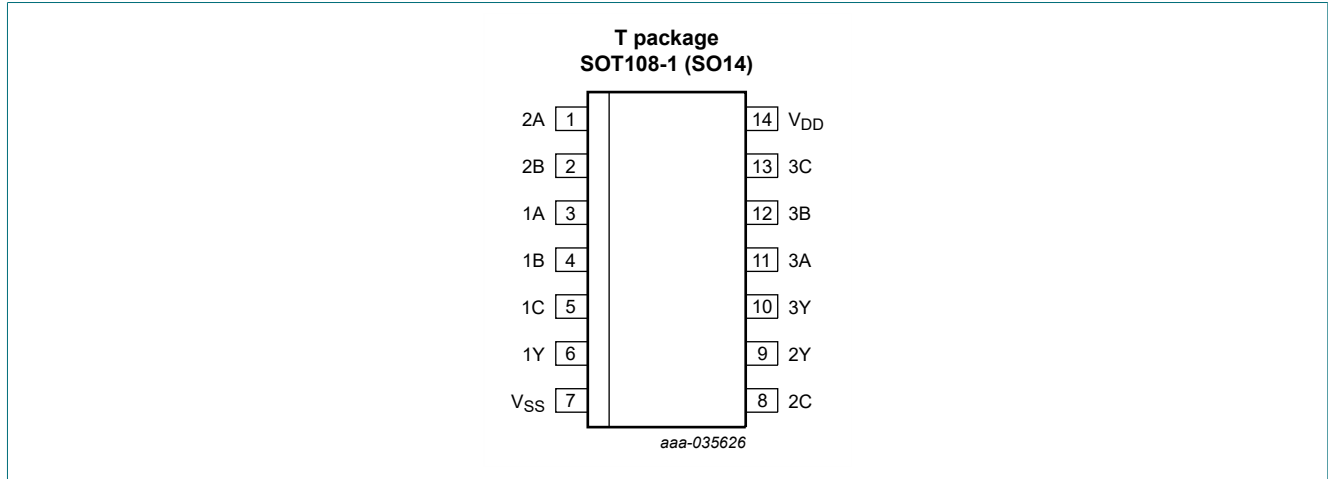


Fig. 2. Logic diagram (one gate)

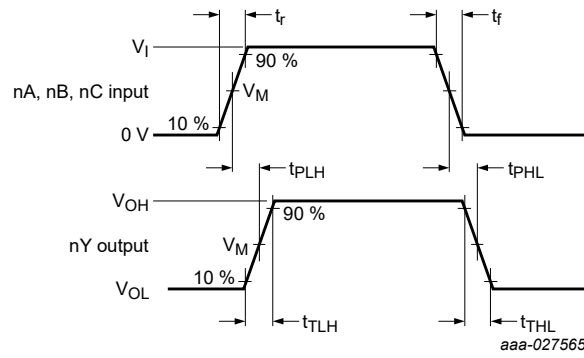

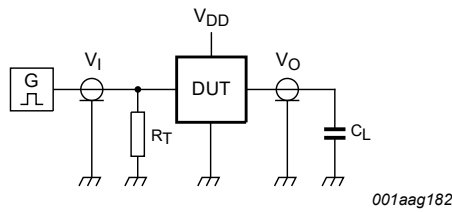

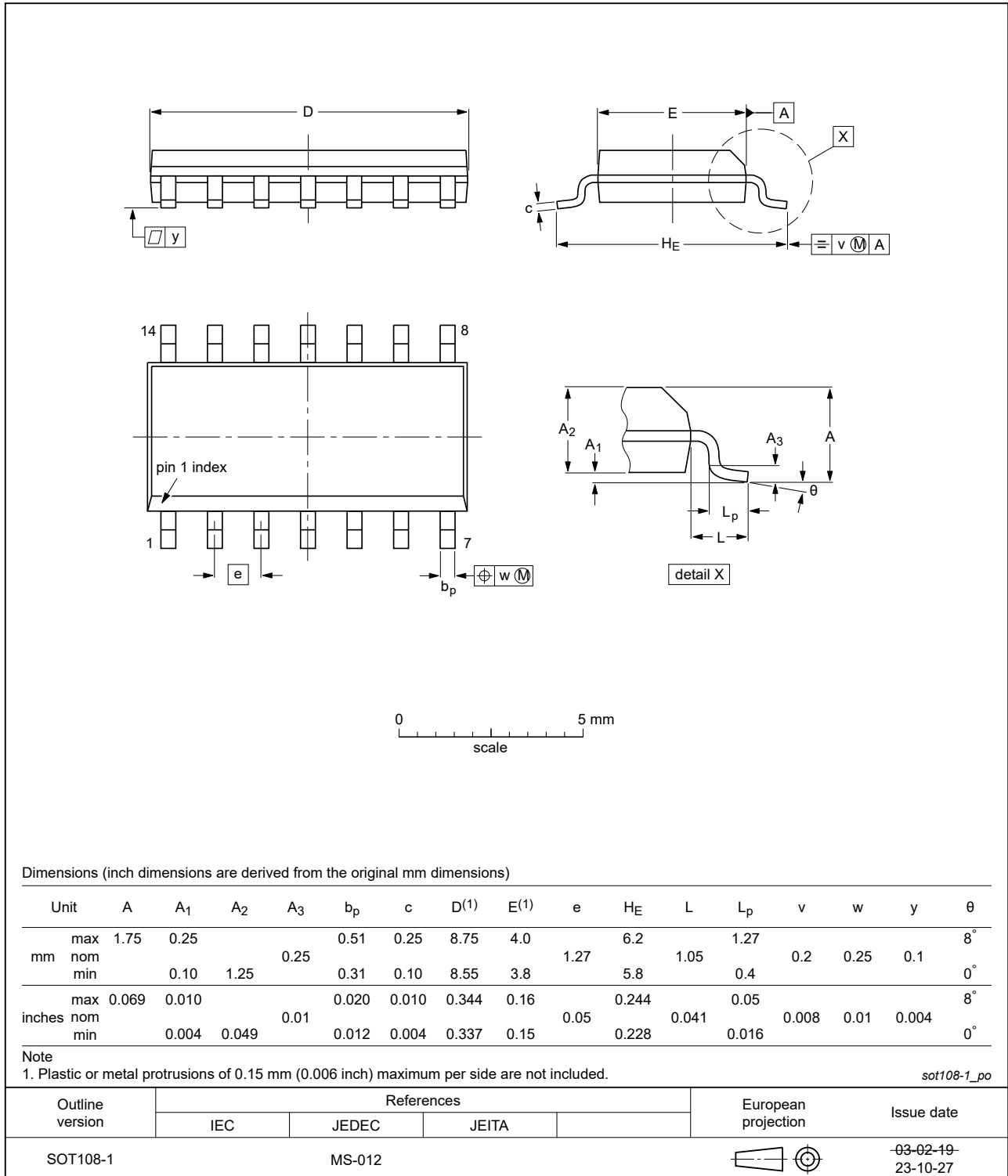


Fig. 5. Package outline SOT108-1 (SO14)
