






Fig. 3. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values




Fig. 4. Collector current as a function of collectoremitter voltage; typical values





Fig. 5. Base-emitter voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

(2) T_{amb} = 25 °C



Fig. 6. Base-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values


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

Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a Fig. 8. function of collector current; typical values





Fig. 9. Collector-emitter saturation resistance as a function of collector current; typical values




 T_{amb} = 25 °C (1) $I_C/I_B = 20$

Fig. 10. Collector-emitter saturation resistance as a function of collector current; typical values






