

1. General description

ESD protection device in an ultra small DFN1110D-3 (SOT8015) leadless Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package with side wettable flanks designed to protect two automotive In-vehicle network bus lines from the damage caused by ElectroStatic discharge (ESD) and other transients.

2. Features and benefits

- Reverse stand-off voltage: V_{RWM} = 24 V
- Low clamping voltage: V_{CL}= 33 V at I_{PP} = 1 A
- ESD protection up to 15 kV (IEC 61000-4-2)
- Low capacitance: C_d = 3.5 pF
- ESD protection up to 15 kV (ISO 10605; C = 150 pF; R = 330 Ω)
- AEC-Q101 qualified



10. Application information

The device is designed for the protection of two automotive in-vehicle bus lines, e.g. CAN (FD), from the damage caused by ESD and surge pulses.



Circuit board layout and protection device placement

Circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD, Electrical Fast Transient (EFT) and surge transients. The following guidelines are recommended:

- **1.** Place the device as close to the input terminal or connector as possible.
- 2. Minimize the path length between the device and the protected line.
- 3. Keep parallel signal paths to a minimum.
- 4. Avoid running protected conductors in parallel with unprotected conductors.
- 5. Minimize all Printed-Circuit Board (PCB) conductive loops including power and ground loops.
- 6. Minimize the length of the transient return path to ground.
- 7. Avoid using shared transient return paths to a common ground point.
- 8. Use ground planes whenever possible. For multilayer PCBs, use ground vias.




