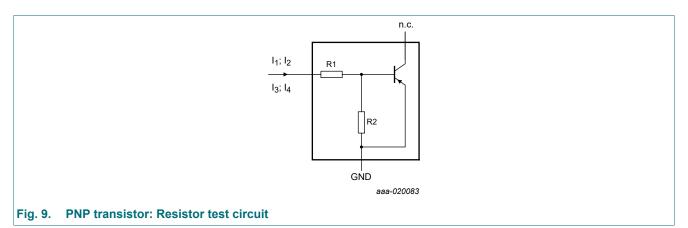
### **Resistor calculation**

$$R_1 = \frac{V(I_2) - V(I_1)}{I_2 - I_1}$$

Calculation of bias resistor ratio (R2/R1)

$$\frac{R2}{R1} = \frac{V(I4) - V(I3)}{R1 \cdot (I4 - I3)} - \frac{1}{2}$$



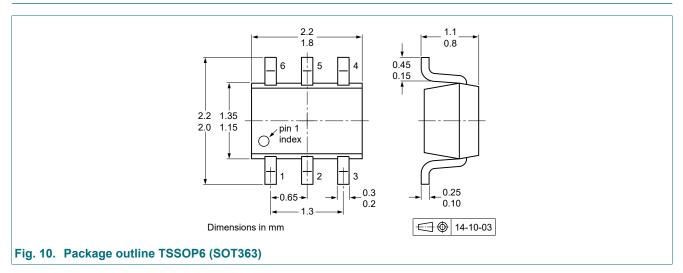

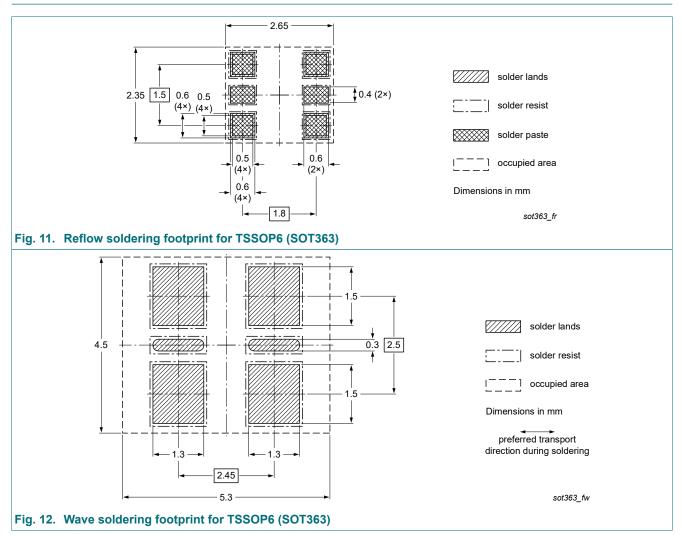
